A jig for three couples danced in a longwise four couple set.
---

bars

- 1-8 First and second couple set and link. First, second, and third couple set and turn their partner with the right hand retain their partners hand and finish in the centre facing up ready for the allemande.
- 9-16 First, second, and third couple dance the allemande.
- 17-24 All three couples dance a petronella turn into the centre to finish, third lady, third man, first lady, first man, second lady, second man. The three ladies are facing down and the three men are facing up. All three couples unravel\*.
- 25-32 First couple turn with the right hand, while second, and third couple cross with the right hand. All three couples take hands on the side and set. First couple dance half a figure of 8 up around second couple and finish in second place.

First couple repeat from second place

\* Unravel (They dance part of a half reel of six passing right shoulder with their partner to begin. As each person reaches the end of the half reel the ladies dance to the right and up the men's side The men dance to the right and down the ladies' side.)
